A NOTE FROM FR BILL MURTAUGH



Before I forget...

Frustration is a sign that we are alive, that we want to do better, achieve more, improve our lives. I think that much of our frustration is the work of the Holy Spirit urging us to use our gifts to create a better world.

I enjoy reading the biographies of people who were frustrated with the status quo and helped create a better world for others: Mother Teresa (the dying and destitute), Martin Luther King Jr. (civil rights), Cesar Chavez (migrant workers), Dorothy Day (the poor), Francis of Assisi (church and environment), Gandhi (non-violence), John XXIII (Church reform), Thomas Merton (spiritual life), the Mayo brothers (medicine), the founders of Alcoholics Anonymous, and the list goes on and on.

We all have a list of things we are frustrated about and God knows there is enough to look at, including the plight of the homeless, refugees, migrants, those among us who suffer with mental illness, violence, terrorism, and the environment. We could even be justified in feeling frustrated with our Church at present.

There is a danger that we can become so overwhelmed with the problems of our times that we are no longer frustrated with things; we have become apathetic. The problems around us are so great that we can walk by them with a certain ease. To be honest, I often get annoyed with my own lack of frustration over how the Church and the world community is less and less like the Church and human community that God wants it to be.

Last weekend the Christian community celebrated the beginning of the Church and the gift of the Holy Spirit given to all the baptized. Let's get frustrated. Let's feel the frustration that Jesus Christ must feel at the present for a Church and a world that allow the treasures of His goodness to be largely ignored. Sit with that frustration and discern what it is doing to you and what it is doing to the Church. Think also of the many gifts you have as a result of God's grace and how you can use them for the glory of God and for a better world.
