# A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE BYRON



It was a great sendoff for Fr. Bill here last weekend. I know that he will be missed by many, and by me. I am quite aware that he had a great deal of behind-the-scenes engineering to do with my coming to Pax Christi as his successor as pastor a year ago, and I think the transition has gone very, very well. I am so grateful for the way in which he has allowed me to find my own role here during these past months, and I admire him for taking on a new responsibility in ministry at his stage of life. (I've told him that I won't be doing that when I am his age!) He will be a great blessing for the parish community of Christ the King in Minneapolis, but it will be our loss. But he's not gone forever. He has already agreed to honor his commitments to the weddings that are on our schedule this year, and has indicated an interest in filling in for the Sunday afternoon Masses on occasion when we have need of that. I will welcome both.

Some have been asking whether and how we are going to replace this loss with another priest. The short answer is that I don't know. We were not offered another ordained minister to replace Fr. Bill, and to some extent that seems to be right. Many of you "old-timers" are aware that when Fr. Tim Power first led this parish, he was adamant that it be organized in a way that we'd only ever need one priest here. The more important reason for that decision is that a truly living church community should not be so clergy-dependent, and I think that this is how we do business today. It's your parish, not narrowly mine. The People of God need a pastor, but not for anything and everything. And the second reason that Fr. Tim expressed this idea was that there simply wouldn't be enough clergy around to staff a parish with more than one ordained minister. This was almost forty years ago...Tim was a wise visionary as well as a great leader. It also helps a lot that the local Franciscan communities have been extraordinarily generous in providing us with sacramental leadership when we have asked them. I plan to continue to ask them!

In other news, the focus of our recent Presbyteral (priests') Assembly in Rochester this past month was on ministry to and with the millennial generation. This was certainly the most engaging assembly we've had in the past decade, because it's the first time in years that we haven't been lectured to by bishops and cardinals (who, I suspect, may be feeling a bit chastened this season), but rather by people who actually have some expertise in a matter of pastoral importance. We are at risk of losing our young adults in the Church, and it is imperative that we understand why that is, and what we can do to address it. This will surely be a topic of future conversation here at Pax Christi and elsewhere.
