

## Commonly Asked Questions for Pax Christi Council Leadership:

- “Who is eligible for Pax Christi Council leadership?” Members of Pax Christi who have been baptized. You can nominate yourself or someone else at Pax Christi. All members of Pax Christi are encouraged to discern for leadership. Pax Christi is a welcoming and inclusive community.
- “Can Youth serve on Councils at Pax Christi?” Yes. We strongly encourage Senior High Youth and college students to discern for Pax Christi leadership.
- “How long are Pax Christi Council terms?” Three years. Senior High Youth serve a one- year term, with an option to renew.
- “Can I be a Council chair?” Yes. This role is open to a member of a Council who has served at least one year. Council chairs can serve a two- year term. Council chairs are selected by their councils by consensus.
- “Can I serve a consecutive term on a Council?” No. Council members must take a one- year break.
- “Can I serve on a Council if I cannot attend all of the A Calling to Leadership events?” Yes. LLDE will walk you through what you will need to do. Council members can also answer questions, or meet with you one on one.
- “If there are more people who would like to join a Council, than spots, how does Pax Christi decide who will serve?” Pax Christi encourages Prayer, Reflection and Community Affirmation for the process.
- “Can snowbirds serve on a Pax Christi Council?” Council members are asked to attend at least 75 percent of Council meetings. Councils do not meet in July.
- “What is the role of the staff liaison?” The staff liaison provides support to the Council. Staff do not have a vote on Council decisions.
