## **Opening Prayer**

## 1. Mission and Vision Reading

### 2. Security Plan and Discussion

Jane noted that Pax Christi has had a security plan in place, last updated in 2008-9. The questions brought to mind by the event at the church in Texas include such things as do we have cameras in the right place, do mass coordinators and staff know what to do to prevent entrance by someone bent on harm. Jane found videos that will be shown to staff on December 6, and possibly then to Mass Coordinators. It was suggested that greeters might benefit from the same sort of training. There was another suggestion that perhaps retired police who are members of the parish could be of help and that perhaps the Archdiocese might have some training also.

### 3. Stewardship Annual Renewal Update

Sara reported that thus far the annual giving is up from last year. Dave noted that the goal is for 100% of the leaders return their renewal cards as a model for the rest of the parish. Council chairs should remind

## 4. Justice Council Update

Jack reported that Justice Council members met to take initial steps in planning their agenda for the next year and then for the next three years. He said that the issues that rose to the top in the rankings for next year were: 1) Racial justice, 2) Education and advocacy, and 3) Environment. He encouraged members to see the Road to Jericho table in Dorothy Day after all Masses on Dec. 2/3 and the Advocacy tables there on January 14.

## 5. Visiting Staff Proposal

Shari passed out an outline of a possible proposal to invite Rev. Julie Neraas to return as a visiting staff member during the 2018/19 fiscal year. The idea would be that the timing might be right as we begin the next strategic plan and that she might bring insights from her previous time in a similar position here in 1985/6. Funding might include the bequest from Fr. Tim's estate and other reserve funds. Several other ideas were brought up in this regard. Fred suggested that we might look for similar persons specifically suited to helping with rolling out the various goals of a new strategic plan. Bruce suggested that we bring the idea to Julie and see what she might propose back to us.
